Jaycees Name Summer Hill Project Heads

Atlanta Jaycees have named committee chairmen for a major project—helping ease living conditions for children in the Summerhill section south of Atlanta Stadium.

The Jaycees project is under the general supervision of John B. Ryan Jr. He is aided by Cliff Baum, in charge of getting play areas in the neighborhood; Larry Westbrook, who is looking into starting Boy Scout troops, and Bob Zimmer, who is working to get a Boys Club for the area.

Zimmer has made arrange-

ments to transport boys by bus from Summerhill to the Carver Boys Club eight miles away.

Zimmer said that there are 1,000 boys in Summerhill who are eligible to become members of a Boys Club.

Jaycee Ryan and Baum have talked to city officials about establishing play areas in the neighborhood, possibly using part of the Atlanta Stadium parking area. City officials, including Stan Martin of the city parks department, have agreed to give cost estimates to im-

prove and furnish a play area.

Westbrook has talked with officials of Atlanta Boy Scouts on establishing troops in the area.

The Jaycees also have established committees to look into the problem of trash pick-up and renovation of buildings in Summerhill.
