Fire Hazards

An inspector will report every violation to the Bureau of Fire Prevention.

Filth Nuisance

Weeds and garbage must not become a menace to public health. Such violation will be referred to the Department of Sanitation. The Department of Sanitation requires the offender to correct the violation or action will be taken at owner or occupants expense. Burning of material giving off offensive odors or dense smoke should be reported to the <u>Air Pollution Control.</u>

Street Lighting

If the street light is burned out, you would call the Louisville Gas and Electric Company. If you desire to request a street light in a certain location you must get a petition circulated in the neighborhood and present it to the <u>Traffic Engineers Office</u>. The petition must have more than half the neighborhood occupants names and addresses signed to it.

Street Paving

Paving of streets is paid for by the City. Patch repairs are also paid for by the City with no charge to the property owner whose property abuts the street where the repair is to be made.

Street Trees

It is the duty of the property owner to keep the trees trimmed. This has been the law since 1892, but in recent years the City of Louisville has been setting aside a small fund with which to pay for this service for property owners in Louisville. At such time that this money is not available for the tree trimming service, the cost will revert to the property owner.

If a property owner wants or needs a tree removed or to do pruning, he must first obtain a permit for this work from the <u>Department of</u> Parks, Forestry Division.

Trash and Garbage

The <u>Department of Sanitation</u> shall remove all ordinary trash and garbage. Containers must be watertight, kept in good condition, and covered at all times with tight fitting lids.

In dwellings of one, two, or three families, each unit supplies their own trash and garbage container. In a dwelling of four or more families, it is the owner's duty to provide containers unless there is an agreement otherwise.

Vacant Houses

It is the duty of the owner to see that the house is kept securely closed to prevent unauthorized entry. A vacant house may be inspected by the Department of Sanitation, Building and Housing, and the Fire Prevention Bureau.

It is the owner's duty to see that the lot is kept free from high weeds, waste, and garbage. Such violation cannot remain on the lot for a period of more than three days after notice by the <u>Depart-</u> ment of Sanitation.


It is unlawful to allow the growth of weeds to become a menace to public health. The owner of the property is to make arrangements to take care of this condition.

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
