made. A survey sheet was sent out into the community to de

-termine the exact nature and scope of the problems to be

considered. From the compilation of information gathered

in the survey, we are now prepared to make certain recom

mendations to the council, as well as to actually set the

Council up. Our recommendations are as follows:

Water Supply:

75% have wells

15% have no wells

10% have running water

Trilet Facilities:

About 75% of the toilets are dilapidated and 85% are pit toilets.

Poultry:

35% of the people has e chivkend.

Diseases :

Common diseases in the community are colds, dental caries, vision deficiences, asthma, malnutrition, heart disease. Pre-adolescents communicable diasease-T.B. and Immediate school problems;

School lunch reem Adequate water supply First aid reem Adequate toilet facilities

We are in need of certain necessary materials and are look
-ing to members of the council to direct us in serving our
community by securing seeds for gardens, adequate lavabry
facilities, better water supply, beaytification of homes, etc.
