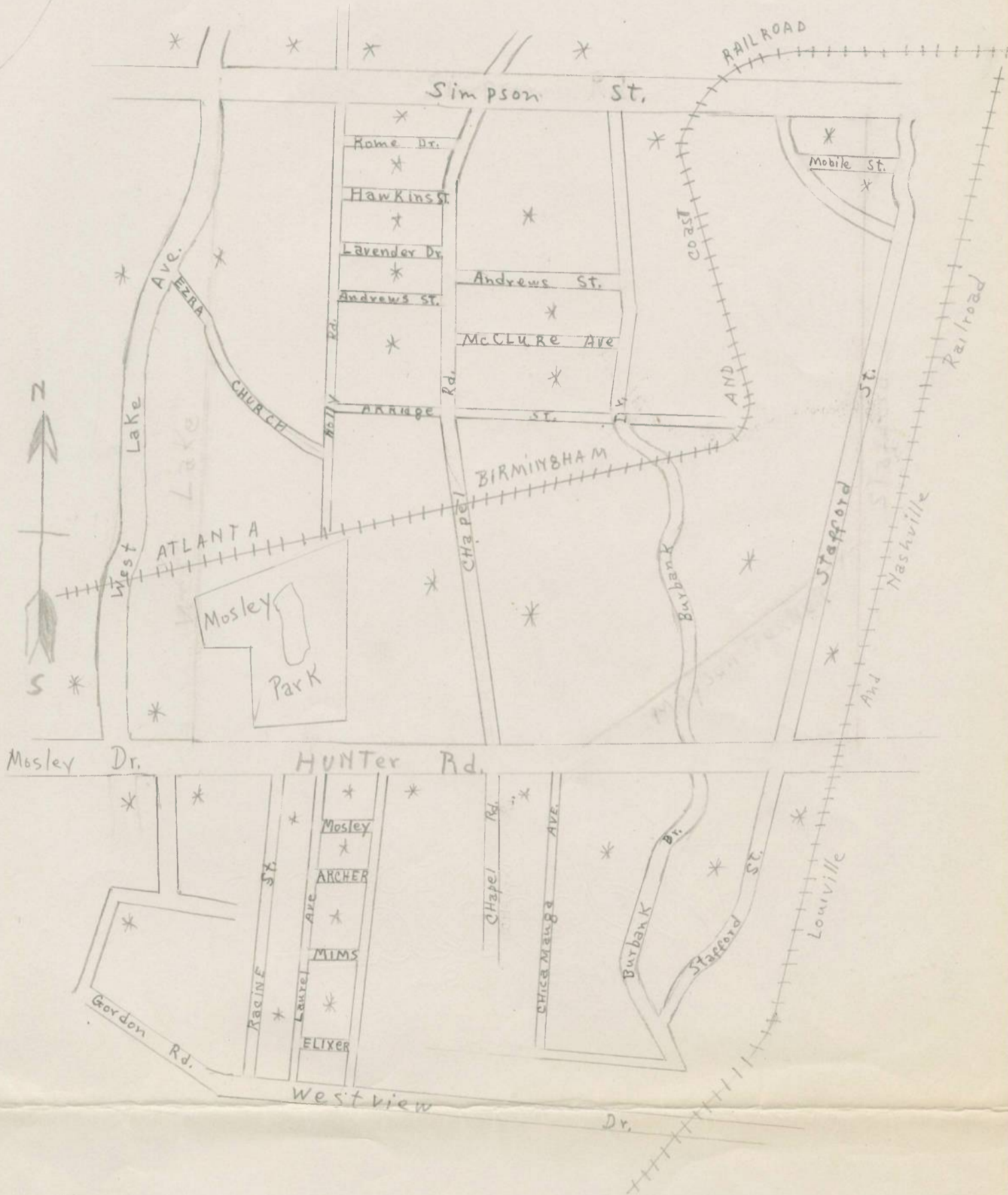
24. What is your general observation regarding race relationship in the neighborhood?
