'Government' Is Theme Of NCC's Coed Weekend

Women legislators from two states will be featured speakers in North Carolina College's 18th annual Coed Weekend, Friday through Sunday.

Theme of the weekend will be "The College Woman's Responsibility in Participation and Leadership in Government, National and Local."

In addition to the symposium featuring Mrs. Grace Hamilton of the Georgia House of Representatives, Mrs. Victorine Q. Adams and Mrs. Lena K. Lee, both of the Maryland House of Delegates, the weekend will include a coffee and conversation hour, two charm clinics, a piano

recital and the presentation of awards to outstanding undergraduate women.

The weekend's program will begin at 3 p.m. Friday, when Mrs. DeVera Edwards, consumer service coordinator for Pharmaco, Inc., of Kenilworth, N.J., will conduct a charm clinic at the women's gymnasium.

The coffee and conversation hours, at 8 p.m. Friday, will feature as speakers, in the student union building, Miss Jean M. Capers, attorney of Cleveland, Ohio; in the education building auditorium, Miss Ruth Harvey, attorney of Danville,

Va.; and in the science building auditorium Dr. Helen Edmonds, dean of NCC's graduate school and a member of the college's interim committee.

The symposium, at 10:30 Saturday morning in B. N. Duke Auditorium, will feature Mrs. Hamilton, representing Georgia's 137th District, Mrs. Adams and Mrs. Lee.

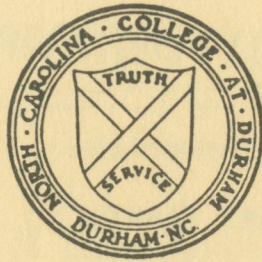
