At the last meeting, a decision was made to present community honorees with a framed award that in some way incorporates the Human Rights Appeal. Several suggestions were made concerning the fabrication of the award for Student honorees. It was suggested that Charnell Holloway in Spelman's Fine Arts Department be asked to participate in submitting a design for the awards. Ms. Holloway is known locally for her sculptures in metal.
