CONSTITUTION OF THE CHATAUQUA CIRCLE. Adopted Nov. 25, 13.

ARTICLE I.

This organization shall be known as The Chatauqua Circle.

Sec. 1. This club shall consist of fifteen ladies. Sec. 2. Vacancies shall be filled as they occur.

Sec. 5. Any lady wishing to sever her connection with the Circle shall do so by sending in a written resignation.

Sec. 4. New members shall be elected by ballot.

ARTICLE III.

The officers of this Circle shall consist of Chairman, Secretary and Treas.

It shall be the duty of the Chairman to preside at the meetings and in case of her absence a temporary Chairman shall be selected. The Secretary shall keep a complete record of all meetings.

ARTICLE V.

The officers of the Circle shall be elected by ballot annually, and no officer shall hold office longer than two consecutive terms.

ARTICLE VI.

This constitution may be amended by 2/3 votes of the Circle.

Any member absent more than three consecutive meetings, without a lawful excuse, will forfeit her membership.
