all that two story wooden building, situate lying and being on the Eastern extremity of Lot Number Eleven in Gamacran in the said City of Savannah

To have and to hold the said *premises*

unto the said *Frederick A. Soper, Guardian as aforesaid, his* —
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to *his* and *their* only proper use and behoof forever. And *we* the said *Henry Castellaw, Guardian of Cassandra Law for ourselves, our* Heirs, Executors and Administrators, the said bargained premises, unto the said *Frederick A. Soper, Guardian as aforesaid, his* —

Executors, Administrators and Assigns, from and against all persons, shall and will WARRANT AND FOREVER DEFEND by these Presents.
