

Bill Roosevelt, 4, White House Host To Rabbit Hero

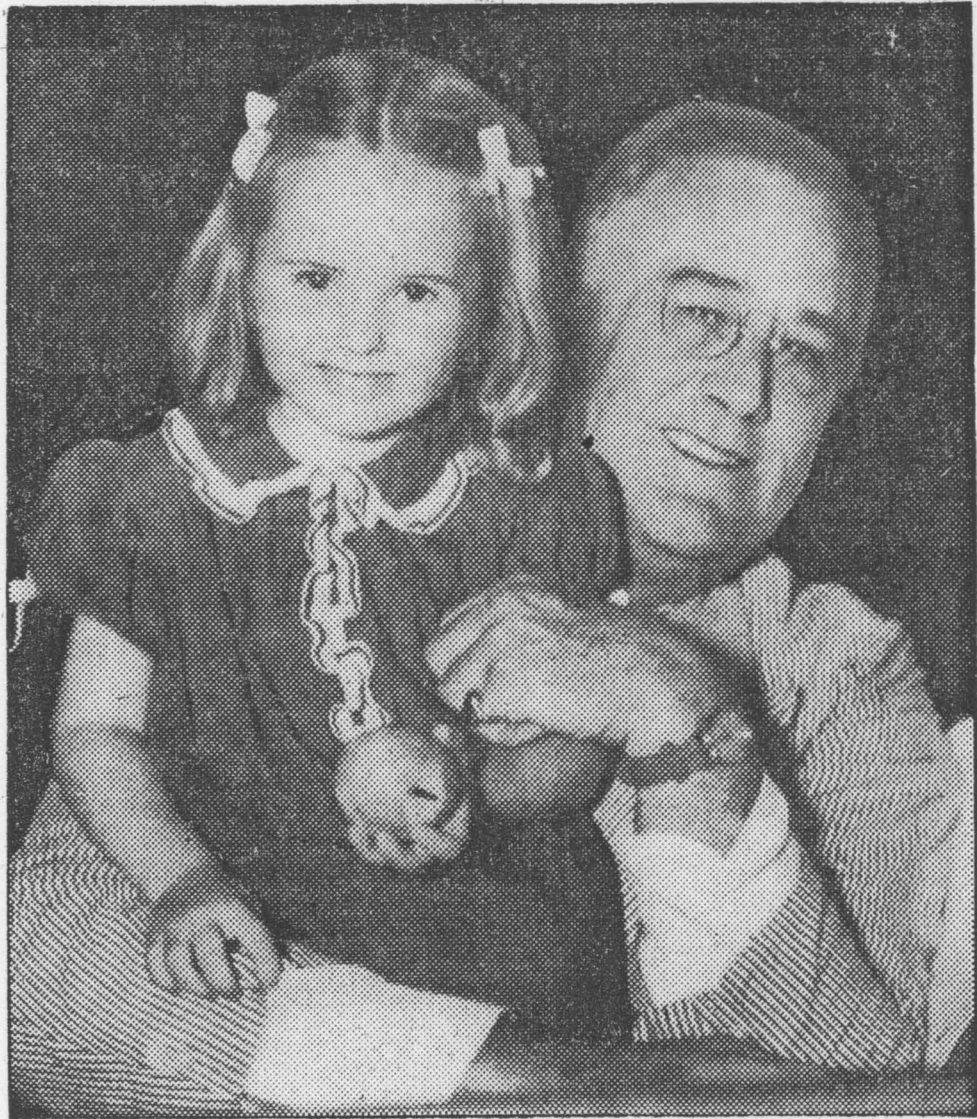

Scamper, a white rabbit which did all but run the White House in a children's book written by President Roosevelt's daughter Anna, played about the grounds in person yesterday.

Bill Roosevelt, 4-year-old son of Mrs. Donner Roosevelt, Philadelphia, divorced wife of the President's son, Elliott, arrived for a visit and couldn't find his book hero. An usher was sent to buy one.

"Will he run down Pennsylvania avenue?" Bill wanted to know. In the book, "Scamper," not only does that but shows visitors through the grounds and in general is quite a sophisticated white rabbit. If he wants to, young Bill may take "Scamper" along when he returns to Philadelphia today, Mrs. Roosevelt said at her press conference but that wouldn't coincide with the book written by his aunt, now Mrs. John Boettiger of Seattle.
