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## History Note

The Freedmen's Aid Society was an agency of the Methodist Episcopal Church created after the Civil War for the purpose of establishing schools and colleges for African Americans in the South. In 1866 the Methodist Episcopal Church held a convention in Cincinnati which organized the Freedmen's Aid Society. The regional annual conferences of the church approved the organization, and the General Conference, the decision-making body of the denomination, of 1868 passed resolutions sanctioning the society. All annual conferences were requested to take collections on its behalf, and the bishops were authorized to appoint a traveling preacher as corresponding secretary. Richard Sutton Rust, a minister from New England and former president of Wilberforce University in Ohio, was selected as the first corresponding secretary and, subsequently, was reelected to this position by the General Conferences of 1872 and 1876.

A great part of the work of the society was in supporting teachers in various institutions begun by or connected with Freedmen's Aid, and in preparing young men for the ministry. There were plans for the creation of a seminary as well. The society was directed by a Board of Managers, which was elected by the General Conference. The denomination also called upon its annual conferences to support the work of the society. The denomination continued to outline the duties and responsibilities of the Freedmen's Aid Society as an agency of the church until its reorganization in 1920. In 1920 the society was reorganized as the Board of Education for Negroes. At the creation of the Methodist Church in 1939, the Board of Education for Negroes and its work were absorbed into the work of the Board of Education.

## **Scope and Content**

The original materials in this collection are housed at the Woodruff Library at Gammon Theological Seminary in Atlanta, Georgia. All requests concerning this microfilm edition should also be directed to the Woodruff Library.

The microfilm edition was created during three filming sessions over a twenty-five-year period. The records are organized into the following series:

### **Series One: Letterpress Books**

The first series consists of 100 letterpress books that document the efforts, business transactions, and administrative activity of the Freedmen's Aid Society as it upheld its charge of "establishing and maintaining institutions of learning in the Southern states among Freedmen and others." At the beginning of each volume is an index, which refers to the correspondence for that particular volume. Included are letters of appeal for contributions from local churches, letters acknowledging receipt of such funds, and receipts for donations to the cause of the society. Other correspondence relates to the placement of individuals as instructors in the educational institutions founded by the Freedmen's Aid Society. Some correspondence is of a personal nature. A few of the letterpress books contain articles on subjects relating to the work of the society.

### **Series Two: Receipt Books**

The second series consists of four receipt books that document, in part, the financial-giving record to the society.

### **Series Three: Stewart Missionary Foundation**

The third series is composed of the financial and administrative records of the Stewart Missionary Foundation for Africa. Included among this set of records are bylaws and a report of the general secretary.

**Series Four: Educational Institutions**

The fourth series contains correspondence of the Freedmen's Aid Society and its successor, the Board of Education for Negroes, with the staff of the various institutions it founded and supported. The twenty-two institutions comprising this project are arranged according to their specific educational objectives and thereunder alphabetically as follows:

For each institution, correspondence with the president appears first, followed by staff correspondence. In the process of sorting the incoming and outgoing letters, a variety of documents surfaced that proved to be stand-alones.

**Series Five: General Correspondence**

The fifth series consists of the general correspondence between the staff and episcopal leaders, local churches and ministers involved in fund-raising, the Board of Managers, trustees, and the staff of Methodist Episcopal boards and agencies. This series also includes correspondence with publishing houses and the business community providing the many and varied financial and maintenance services required to operate an educational institution within the various communities where they were established. Persons having a letter volume of seven or fewer were assigned to a general alphabetical letter folder. Persons generating a volume of eight or more letters were assigned their own individual folder.

**Series Six: Correspondence between Staff Members**

Correspondence between staff members is confined to the sixth series. In the main, it relates to travel plans and their revisions, and the instructions that a traveling executive writes to the home office regarding work priorities while on the road for a considerable length of time.

**Series Seven: Personal Correspondence**

The seventh series includes letters discussing personal matters not directly related to the administrative work of the Freedmen's Aid Society and its successor.

**Series Eight: Remaining Documents**

The eighth series holds the remaining documents screened from the correspondence and includes minutes, reports, printed matter, photographs, financial records, a letter book, forms, and lists.
