RE: RAISE

It has now been slightly over six months since I came to JPC, and I would like at this time to request my first raise. I am aware that salaries usually come under consideration after three months. But I felt, because of the nature and responsibilities of my particular position with BLACK WORLD, that we should all be given sufficient time to judge our satisfaction.

I am requesting a maximum increase of \$60 per week, which would make my check approximately \$466 every two weeks. The minimum I am asking is \$50 per week, which would increase my two week check to \$446.

I would appreciate receiving a reply on this matter as soon as possible and thank you for your attention.
